

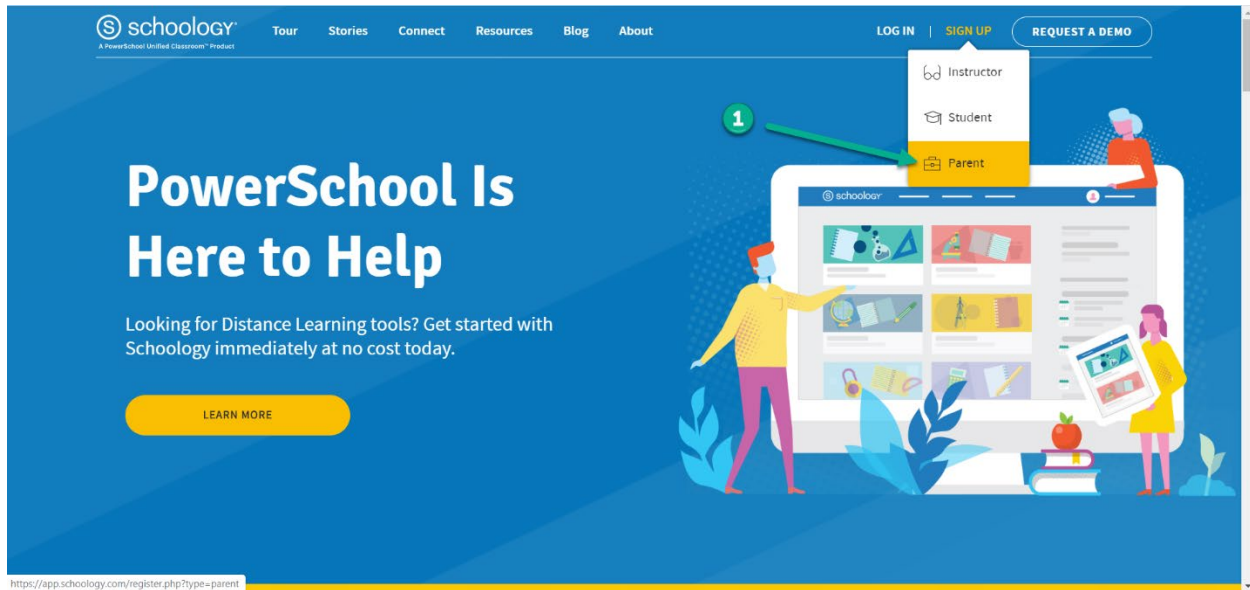


Signing Up for Parent Accounts in Schoology



Go to schoolology.com and select “Sign Up” (this process is for parents only – students use wskids.schoolology.com).

1. Select “Parent.”



2. Enter the “Access Code” provided by your teacher.
3. Select “Continue.”

4. Enter “First Name, Last Name, Email Address and Password.”
5. “Acknowledge” the Privacy Policy and Terms of Use.
6. Select “Register.”
